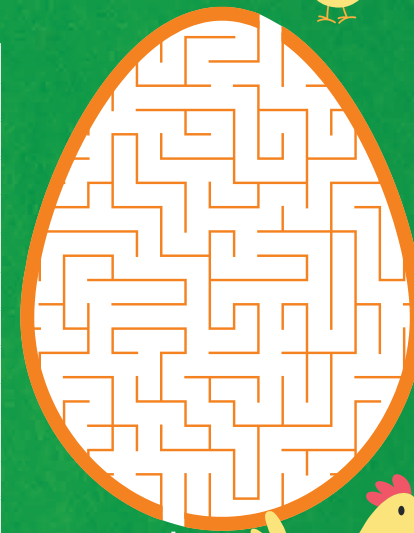
Hop to trail point 1 to start the trail. You can locate each egg by using the map on the back of this trail leaflet.
