## Nature Park grant: Example of a completed costing table

NB. It's ok to not know the exact price of everything when you apply and it's ok to change your mind about what you are going to spend your grant on... as long as your new idea fits within these categories. You need to give an *indication* about which financial year you will be spending your money in, it's ok if things change.

In this example, the school have decided to get planters for the playground, seeds, compost and flowers. They have also decided to buy plants which will be able to climb up their fences to add biodiversity and to create a green screen. The school have decided to get some wildflower seeds to create a wildflower patch on an existing grass space. The school also have an existing pond which they would like to add enhance with some planting. To help build and install their new biodiversity features, the school will be spending some of their grant on external contractors.

To support with the maintenance, the school will get some waterbutts for rainwater harvesting and some solar powered irrigation for their planters, a class set of gardening gloves, additional gardening tools and potting trays to help pupils grow and pot up the plants they've grown from seed. The school are getting some more wet weather gear and outdoor storage for their new tools. They are also getting some tablet devices so the pupils can take part in Nature Park activities and a few wildlife cameras to capture the new biodiversity visiting their school!
