Once registered, names and classifications may be changed only with the agreement of the International Cultivar Registration Authority, upon application to the International Registrar.

## NOTES ON CLASSIFICATION AND DESCRIPTION

## Note 1 - on classification

The combination of division and colour code assigned here (or as amended in any future Supplement) is the registered classification, to be observed, for example, when schedules require cultivars to be shown "as registered". The registered classification is not altered by any note of variable measurement or colour.

## Note 2 - on colour coding

Guidelines on colour coding, including those on distinguishing between Yellow and Orange and between Orange and Red, appear in the Register and on registration forms. It is at the registrant's discretion to distinguish White from Yellow or Green, Yellow from Green, or Pink from the paler tones of Orange or Red.

In addition:

## - Green at corona base

The green at the base of a corona, whether in the tube or in the corona itself, may be included in the colour code if it is prominent and plain to see.
Registrants are advised to include it only if it is consistent from year to year.

- Non-concentric colours

When coding colours in perianth or corona that appear in radial rather than concentric bands, or in a flare from the base, or in flecks or splashes: start with a letter for the predominant colour; proceed with an oblique line; follow with the letter(s) (in any order) for the non-predominant colour(s).

For example, a yellow flower with a white streak along the midrib of the perianth segments would be Y/W-Y; a white flower with radial bands of orange and yellow on the corona segments would be W-W/OY.

## Note 3 - on colour terms

Colour Chart numbers in registered descriptions, e.g. 'Amira' brilliant yellow 8A, are from the RHS Colour Chart (1966, 1986, 1995, 2001, 2007, 2015). Colour names followed by Chart numbers without brackets are equivalents adopted by the RHS for all its international registers. They are taken from the Universal Colour Language in the Inter-Society Color Council-National Bureau of Standards colour-name system. Colour names followed by Chart numbers with brackets or by no numbers at all are those supplied by the registrant.

## Note 4 - on description

Registered descriptions are drawn up from application forms and, whenever possible, from photographs and specimens. The Registrar would welcome readers' comments on the accuracy of all descriptions.
Illustrations of descriptive terms appear on page 24.

## Note 5 - on height

Stem heights in registered descriptions may be taken to be Standard ( $325-675 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) unless otherwise stated, when they will be described as Dwarf (less than 325 mm ) or Tall (more than 675 mm ).

## Note 6 - on Nomenclatural Standards

The Standard noted at the end of some descriptions is the designated herbarium specimen or illustration forming a permanent record of the distinguishing characteristics of the cultivar and fixing the cultivar name. These are maintained at the RHS Herbarium, Wisley.

## Note 7 - on unregistered names

Names listed as 'unregistered' are those post-1955 that have not been accepted by the RHS or have not yet been submitted for registration. They are included as part of the Check List and they gain no registered status by being listed. They are included in order to prevent confusion between daffodils of the same name and to help prevent further duplication.

The following 140 cultivar names were registered between $1^{\text {st }}$ December 2020 and 30 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ June 2021 by The Royal Horticultural Society, International Cultivar Registration Authority for the genus Narcissus.

Fl. 105 mm wide; perianth segments 40 mm long; corona 12 mm long. Mid-season.
Etymology: named after registrant's beautiful dog A.J. who passed away

'Jersey Lace' open pollinated
Fl. 96 mm wide; perianth segments 40 mm long, roundish, very broad, blunt or truncate, prominently mucronate, white, reflexed, concave or with margins wavy, with midrib showing, of membranaceous substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, more nearly spreading, shouldered at base, truncate, scarcely mucronate; corona 11 mm long, split to half its length into six segments, each closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an inner and an outer whorl of three, yellow, with a broad band of orange at rim, ribbed and frilled, with rim crenate. Mid-season.

Fl. 90 mm wide; perianth segments in three whorls, greenish white 155 A ; the outer whorl 35 mm long, broadly ovate, rounded at apex, prominently mucronate, spreading, with margins incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner whorls shorter and inflexed towards centre, with margins incurling or irregularly folded; corona segments 20 mm long, brilliant yellow 8A, interspersed among the two inner perianth whorls and clustered at centre, heavily frilled and crenate. Early. Strongly scented.

Fl. 106 mm wide; perianth segments 43 mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, lemon yellow, with a narrow band of white at base, and white mucro, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, creased, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower; corona 40 mm long, cylindrical to narrow funnel-shaped, broadly ribbed, coral pink, mouth straight and wavy, with rim shallowly notched and flanged. Mid-season.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by hybridiser (WSY0136870)
Etymology: In honour of Anna Pavord on her $80^{\text {th }}$ birthday

Mid-season.

Etymology: commemorates exhibitions at Cincinnati Art Museum

long, in two whorls, white, ovate, spreading, plane, with margins incurling, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; corona segments yellow, with pink at rim. Mid-season

Fl. star-shaped, 24 mm wide, facing downwards; perianth segments ovate, acute, blunt, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping a quarter; the inner segments slightly narrower; corona narrow funnel-shaped, angled, mouth straight and slightly wavy, with rim notched. Dwarf.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136993)
Etymology: named in honour of registrant's late mother

Etymology: named for the place where the registrant's late wife spent her childhood

Mid-season to late.

Mid-season.

Fl. star-shaped, 67 mm wide, facing downwards; perianth segments 28 mm long, ovate or oblong, blunt, white, touched green at base, prominently mucronate, spreading or a little reflexed, plane or wavy, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping a third to a half; the inner segments narrower, less prominently mucronate; corona 20 mm long, cylindrical, angled, orange, a little paler towards base, mouth expanded, wavy and broadly ribbed, with rim crenate. Dwarf. Early.

Fl. 93 mm wide; perianth segments 36 mm long, roundish, very broad, blunt or truncate, mucronate, white, touched yellow at base, spreading or a little reflexed, shallowly concave, creased and of membranaceous substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, scarcely mucronate, shouldered at base, spreading, somewhat wavy and notched at margins; corona 11 mm long, bowl-shaped, smooth, yellow, with a band of strong orange at rim, mouth widely expanded, lobed and heavily frilled, lobes overlapping, with rim crenate. Mid-season. Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136932)

Fl. forming a double triangle, 115 mm wide; perianth segments 43 mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, spreading, plane, with margins a little incurling, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base; corona 45 mm long, funnel-shaped, smooth, mouth straight and wavy, with rim dentate and broadly flanged. Early.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136988)
Etymology: named for the famous pub landlady of the Gwaun Valley

Fl. 90 mm wide; perianth segments 37 mm long, roundish, very broad, truncate, yellow, with pale mucro, spreading, shallowly concave, with margins narrowly incurved at apex, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, more nearly ovate, scarcely mucronate, with midrib showing; corona 9 mm long, funnel-shaped, ribbed, yellow, with a broad band of reddish orange at rim, mouth straight and wavy, with rim minutely crenate. Mid-season to late.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136866)
Etymology: named after Birr Castle, County Offaly, Republic of Ireland

Fl. star-shaped, 145 mm wide; perianth segments 21 mm long, oblong, acute, reflexed, plane, with margins incurling, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping a quarter; corona 19 mm long, cylindrical, strongly ribbed, mouth straight and frilled, with rim dentate, Dwarf. Mid-season

## 'Bobby Dazzler' 11a W-R

'Magician' $\times$ 'Diversity'; sdlg no. 3706
Fl. forming a double triangle, 98 mm wide; perianth segments 35 mm long, roundish, very broad, blunt, mucronate, white, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, a little creased, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, ovate, scarcely mucronate, somewhat shouldered at base; corona 18 mm long, split almost to base into six segments, each closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an outer and inner whorl of three, bi-lobed, almost as wide as the inner segments, deep pinkish red, a little lighter in tone towards rim, wavy and crenate. Early to mid-season.

Fl. forming a double triangle, 108 mm wide, pure white; perianth segments 40 mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, spreading, plane, with midrib showing, of membranaceous substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, somewhat shouldered at base; corona 26 mm long, funnel-shaped, smooth, mouth straight, wavy to lightly frilled, with rim crenate. Mid-season.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136867)
Etymology: named for founder of the Irish Garden Plant Society

## 'Chemin-A-Haut' 2 W-O

Fl. forming a double triangle, 95 mm wide; perianth segments 35 mm long, ovate, blunt, white, touched very pale yellow at base, with prominent white mucro, spreading, plane, smooth and of membranaceous substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, somewhat shouldered at base, less prominently mucronate; corona 21 mm long, narrow funnel-shaped, angled, orange, touched yellowish orange at base, mouth straight, wavy and irregularly lobed, with rim crenate. Early to mid-season.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0170001)
Etymology: pronounced "shemn-a-HAW", it is the French name (meaning "high road") for the trail used by Native Americans in their seasonal migrations. The trail runs north/south along the west side of the Mississippi River

Early. Slightly scented.

Fl. 100 mm wide; perianth segments 42 mm long, roundish, very broad, yellow, touched white at base and with pale mucro, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower; corona 44 mm long, cylindrical, smooth, yellow, mouth flared, broadly ribbed and lightly frilled, with rim crenate. Mid-season.

Etymology: named for hybridiser's husband, Joy
'Consent' 2 W-Y

'Ice Follies' sport
Fl. forming a double triangle, 90 mm wide; perianth segments 38 mm long, ovate, blunt, slightly mucronate, spreading, plane, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping one-third; the inner segments narrower; corona 30 mm long, funnel-shaped, ribbed, light yellow, mouth straight and frilled, with rim dentate to notched and widely flanged. Early. Sweetly scented. Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136994)

Fl. forming a double triangle, 105 mm wide; perianth segments 40 mm long, broadly ovate, blunt,
mucronate, white, spreading, concave, with margins incurling, creased and of membranaceous substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments a little narrower; corona 27 mm long, broad and shallow funnel-shaped, smooth, opening orange-yellow, maturing to white, with a broad band of yellow at rim and touched yellow at base, mouth straight and lightly frilled, with rim notched. Early.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136916)

## 'Cremello' 2 Y-Y

Fl. forming a double triangle, 122 mm wide; perianth segments 50 mm long, broadly ovate, blunt,
mucronate, spreading, plane, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, scarcely mucronate; corona 48 mm long, narrow funnel-shaped, smooth, a little darker in tone than perianth segments, mouth frilled and broadly
ribbed, with rim widely flanged. Early.

Parentage unknown; sdlg no. 08-84
Fl. rounded, 105 mm wide; perianth segments 37 mm long, roundish, very broad, blunt, slightly mucronate, spreading, plane, with margins narrowly incurling, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base; corona segments 31 mm long, split almost to base into six segments, each as wide as and closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an inner and an outer whorl of three, bi-lobed, with lobes overlapping, frilled and minutely crenate. Mid-season.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136954)

## 'Dawn Parade' 2 W-YYO

Fl. rounded, 110 mm wide; perianth segments 45 mm long, very broadly ovate, rounded at apex, mucronate, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; corona 41 mm long, cylindrical, smooth, mouth wavy and slightly flared, with rim crenate. Tall. Early to mid-season.
Etymology: the Dawn Parade is held in New Zealand on ANZAC Day to commemorate returned servicemen and women, and those who lost their lives in war

Fl. 64 mm wide, facing upwards; perianth segments 51 mm long, roundish, very broad, blunt, yellow, with pale midrib and mucro, spreading, plane or with margins slightly recurved, smooth and of membranaceous substance, overlapping one-third; the inner segments narrower; corona 19 mm long, bowlshaped, smooth, white, with broad band of pink at rim and yellow at base, mouth flared and ribbed, with rim frilled and dentate. Early. Sweetly scented.
Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0136995)
Etymology: nickname for registrant's mother-in-law

## HORTICULTURAL CLASSIFICATION

Whether of wild or cultivated origin, once a selection has been distinguished by a cultivar name it should be assigned to Divisions 1-12. Daffodils distinguished solely by botanical name should be assigned to Division 13.

## Notes

1. The characteristics for Divisions 5 to 10 are given for guidance only; they are not all necessarily expected to be present in every cultivar assigned to those divisions
2. Divisions 12 and 13 are not illustrated owing to the wide variation in shape and size between the flowers involved

## DIVISION 1 - TRUMPET DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



One flower to a stem; corona ("trumpet") as long as, or longer than the perianth segments ("petals")

## DIVISION 2 -LARGE-CUPPED DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



One flower to a stem; corona ("cup") more than one-third, but less than equal to the length of the perianth segments ("petals")

## DIVISION 3 - SMALL-CUPPED DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



One flower to a stem; corona ("cup") not more than one-third the length of the perianth segments ("petals")

## DIVISION 4 - DOUBLE DAFFODIL

 CULTIVARS

One or more flowers to a stem, with doubling of the perianth segments or the corona or both

## DIVISION 5-TRIANDRUS DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



Characteristics of N. triandrus clearly evident: usually two or more pendent flowers to a stem; perianth segments reflexed

## DIVISION 6 - CYCLAMINEUS DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



Characteristics of N. cyclamineus clearly evident: one flower to a stem; perianth segments significantly reflexed; flower at an acute angle to the stem, with a very short pedicel("neck")

## DIVISION 7 - JONQUILLA AND APODANTHUS DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



Characteristics of Sections Jonquilla or Apodanthi clearly evident: one to five (rarely eight) flowers to a stem; perianth segments spreading or reflexed; corona cup-shaped, funnel-shaped or flared, usually wider than long; flowers usually fragrant

## DIVISION 8 - TAZETTA DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



Characteristics of Section Tazettae clearly evident: usually three to twenty flowers to a stout stem; perianth segments spreading not reflexed; flowers usually fragrant

## DIVISION 9 - POETICUS DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



Characteristics of N. poeticus and related species clearly evident; perianth segments pure white; corona very short or disc-shaped, not more than one-fifth the length of the perianth segments; corona usually with a green and/or yellow centre and red rim, but sometimes wholly or partly of other colours; anthers usually set at two distinct levels; flowers fragrant

## DIVISION 10 - BULBOCODIUM DAFFODIL CULTIVARS



Characteristics of Section Bulbocodium clearly evident: usually one flower to a stem; perianth segments insignificant compared with the dominant corona; anthers dorsifixed(ie attached more or less centrally to the filament); filament and style usually curved

DIVISION 11 -SPLIT-CORONA DAFFODIL CULTIVARS
Corona split - usually for more than half its length

a) Collar Daffodils Split-corona daffodils with the corona segments opposite the perianth segments; the corona segments usually in two whorls of three

b) Papillon Daffodils Split-corona daffodils with the corona segments alternate to the perianth segments; the corona segments usually in a single whorl of six

## DIVISION 12 - OTHER DAFFODIL

 CULTIVARSDaffodil cultivars which do not fit the definition of any other division
