The following list contains the delphinium cultivar names registered between 1st January 2020 and 31st December 2020.

R = raiser, **H** = hybridiser, **G** = person who grew the plant to first flowering, **S** = selected by, **N** = person naming the plant, **I** = introducer, **REG** = registrant.

Colour Chart numbers in descriptions e.g., light purple (85C), are from the *RHS Colour Chart* (1966, 1986, 1995, 2001, 2007, 2015).

D. 'Nymphs' Delight' Elatum group

'Centurion Lavender' hybrid

H (2017), **G** (2018), **N** (2019), **I** & **REG** (2020) by Ladislav Čavis

Stems short (90cm). Foliage serrated, green. Spikes 55cm, tapering to apex, 3-4 laterals. Flowers fully double, 45-50mm wide, the outer sepals light purple (85C), the inner sepals light purple with light yellowish green 142A along midrib; eye light green (144C); pedicels 90mm long; spurs 20mm long. Flowering early June onwards through summer months and into autumn.

D. 'Regal Splendour' Elatum group

Parentage unknown

G, **I** (2014) Mrs J. Woolley; **N** & **REG** (2020) by Mrs J. Woolley & Graham Austin Home Farm Plants.

Stems medium (150-160cm). Foliage serrated, dark green. Spikes 50-60cm, tapering to apex, 4-6 laterals, 20-25cm long. Flowers semi-double, 60-80mm wide, the outer sepals blue, the inner sepals violet blue with blue along midrib and at margins; eye brown with yellow hairs; spurs 20-25mm long. Flowering early (late May-early June).
