Raisers and introducers of new delphiniums are encouraged to ensure that the names of all their plants have been registered. The following list contains the delphinium cultivar names registered between 1st January 2024 and 31st December 2024. Colour Chart numbers in descriptions e.g., light blue (101C), are from the RHS Colour Chart (1966, 1986, 1995, 2001, 2007, 2015) unless otherwise stated.

R = raiser, **H** = hybridiser, **G** = person who grew the plant to first flowering, **S** = selected by, **N** = person naming the plant, **I** = introducer, **REG** = registrant.

Delphinium 'Annalise' Elatum hybrid
'Raymond Lister' × 'Loch Leven'
H (2019); **G** (2020); **N, I & REG** (2024) by
Christopher Dreisch (Stafford, Connecticut, USA)
Stems medium (150–190cm). Foliage medium
green. Spikes 1m long, tapering to apex, with 3 to
6 laterals per stem. Flowers semi-double, 75mm
wide; outer sepals light blue, inner petals lilac,
with white eye; spur length 10mm, pedicel length
(middle of spike) 35mm.
Colour stays strong in the sun and the petals hold
up well in the rain.
Flowers mid-June to late-June/early July

Delphinium 'Duncan Alexander' Elatum hybrid

H (1998) Duncan McGlashan; **G** (2001), **I** (2014), **N** (2024), & **REG** (2024) by Mark Lyman

Stems medium (1.5m). Foliage clean. Spikes 0.8m long, tapering to apex. Flowers semi-double, 75mm wide, pure mid-blue, eye white sometimes with blue stripes; spur length short; pedicel length short.

***Delphinium* 'Tegan Pounds'** Elatum hybrid

Parentage unknown

H (2020); **G** (2021); **N** (2024); **I** (2024) & **REG** (2024) by Trevor Pounds (Marlow, Buckinghamshire)

Stems medium (1.7m). Foliage mid-green. Spikes 70cm long, tapering to apex. Flowers semi-double; outer sepals light blue, paler towards base; inner petals violet (92B), with outer margin blue (101C); eye brown.

Etymology: named for registrant's daughter
