
Our Beth

(Modern Shrub) Delightful highly fragrant, double, rosette, soft blush pink flowers with a deeper centre, opening flat from rounded buds to a beautiful old fashioned cushion shape. An alluring rose, with plentiful dark green foliage on a vigorous wide growing shrub, which can with training be grown as a small climber. Also suitable to be grown in a container, as a hedge and used for cut flowers. This rose is a perfect alternative to 'Geoff Hamilton' which we no longer stock. Bred by Beales.

STARS OF THE SHOW

Pippin

(Climbing Rose) Full, cushioned blooms of warm pink produced freely amongst dark glossy foliage, on a strong and healthy plant. Fragrance is sweet but not overpowering. Bred by Beales.

Excelsa

(Wichurana Rambler) Large trusses of small, light cerise crimson flowers on spindly but strong shoots. Very vigorous. A long flowering season, then occasional repeats, until winter. Tolerant of poor soils and shade. One of the most useful Wichurana ramblers as is suitable to be grown against a north wall and up into trees. Bred by Walsh.
